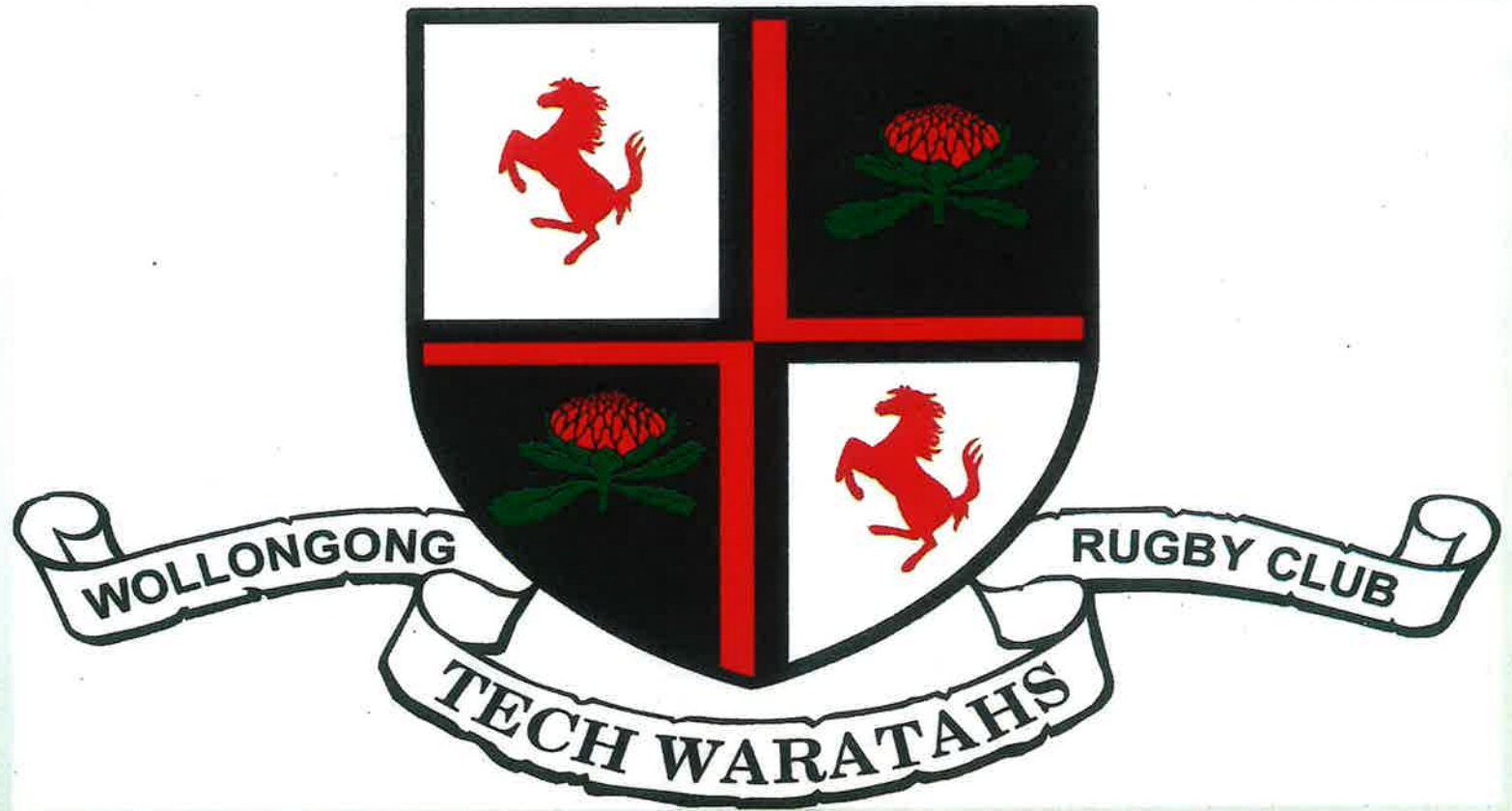

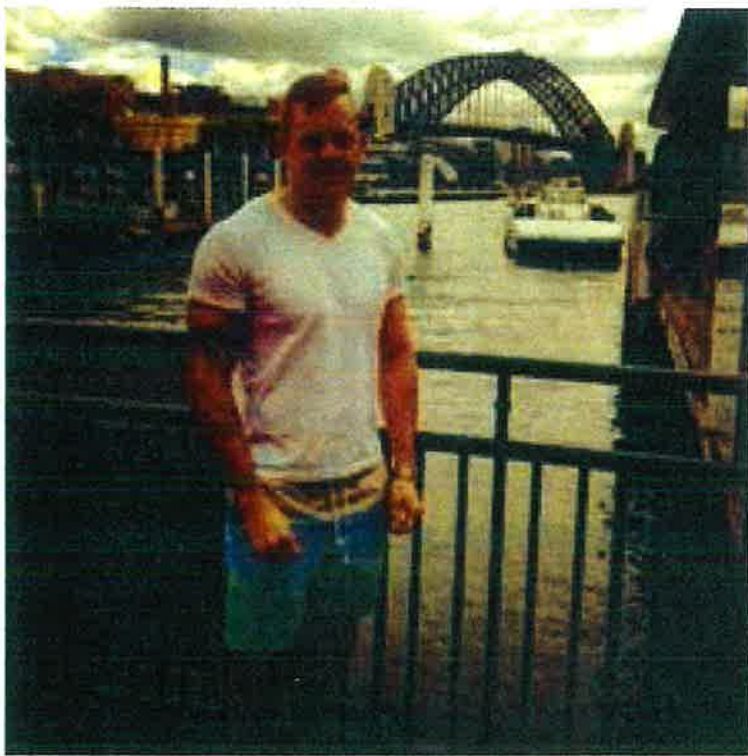

PRESIDENT'S REPORT

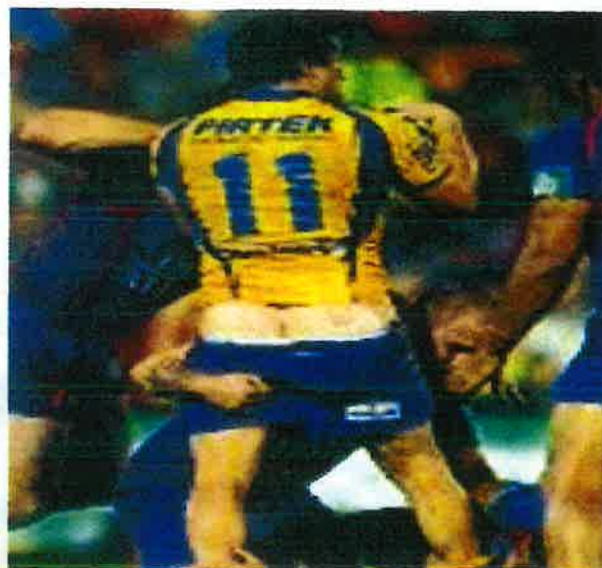

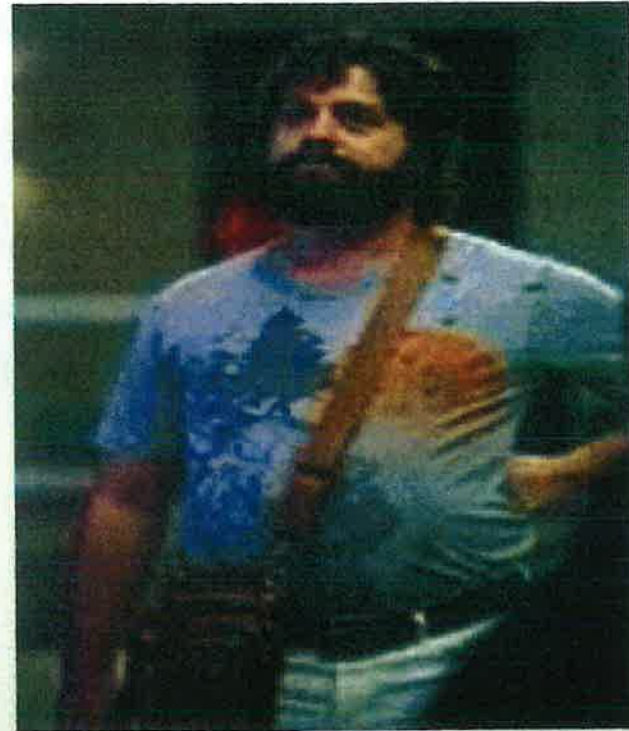
In closing I would like to say I have had a great time this year as Junior President and cannot wait to watch the club continue to grow over the next few years.
