I would like to thank Mark Fox and Ean Torpy for their assistance at training and in particular Ean for organising the teams on Saturdays.

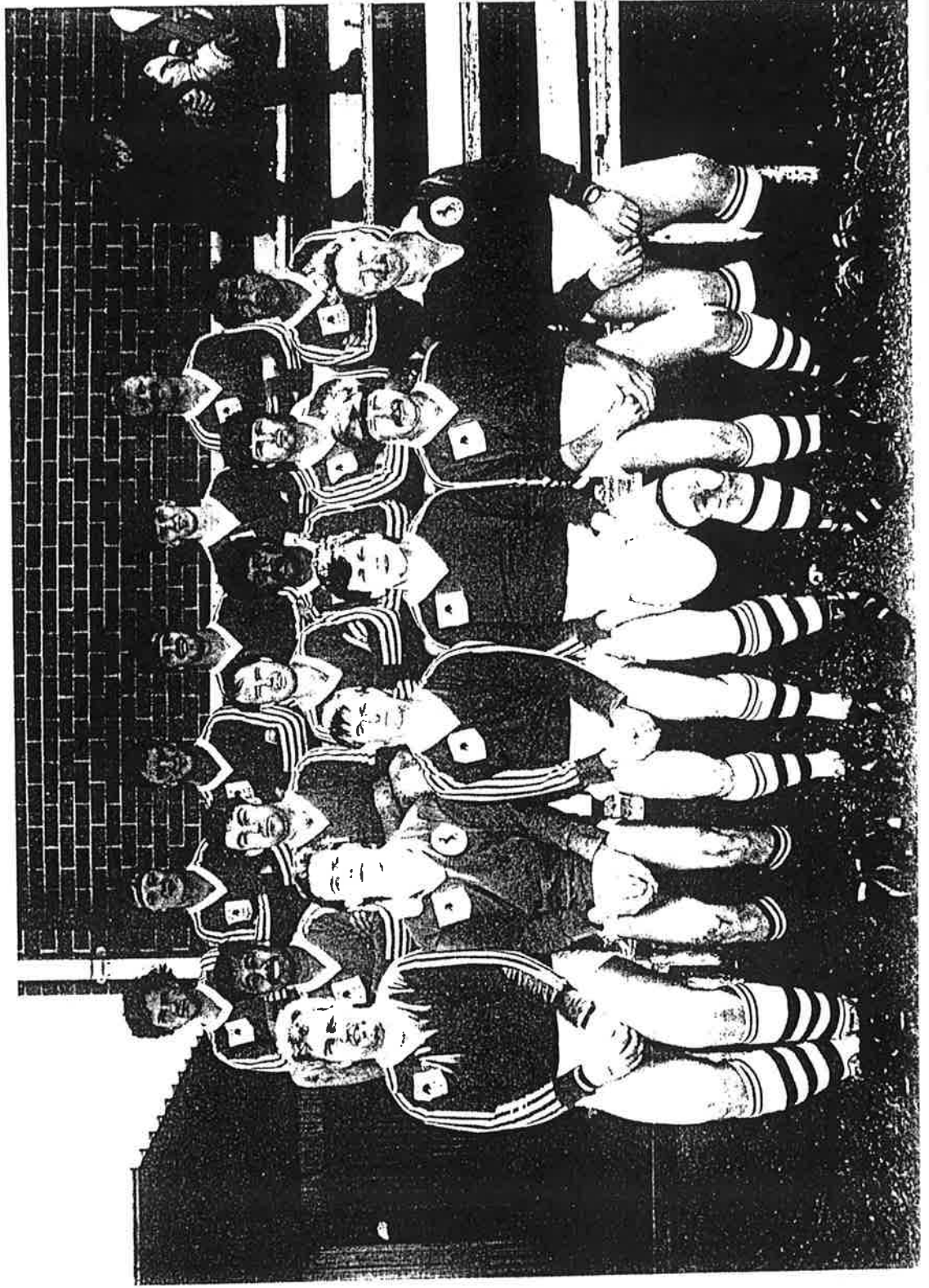

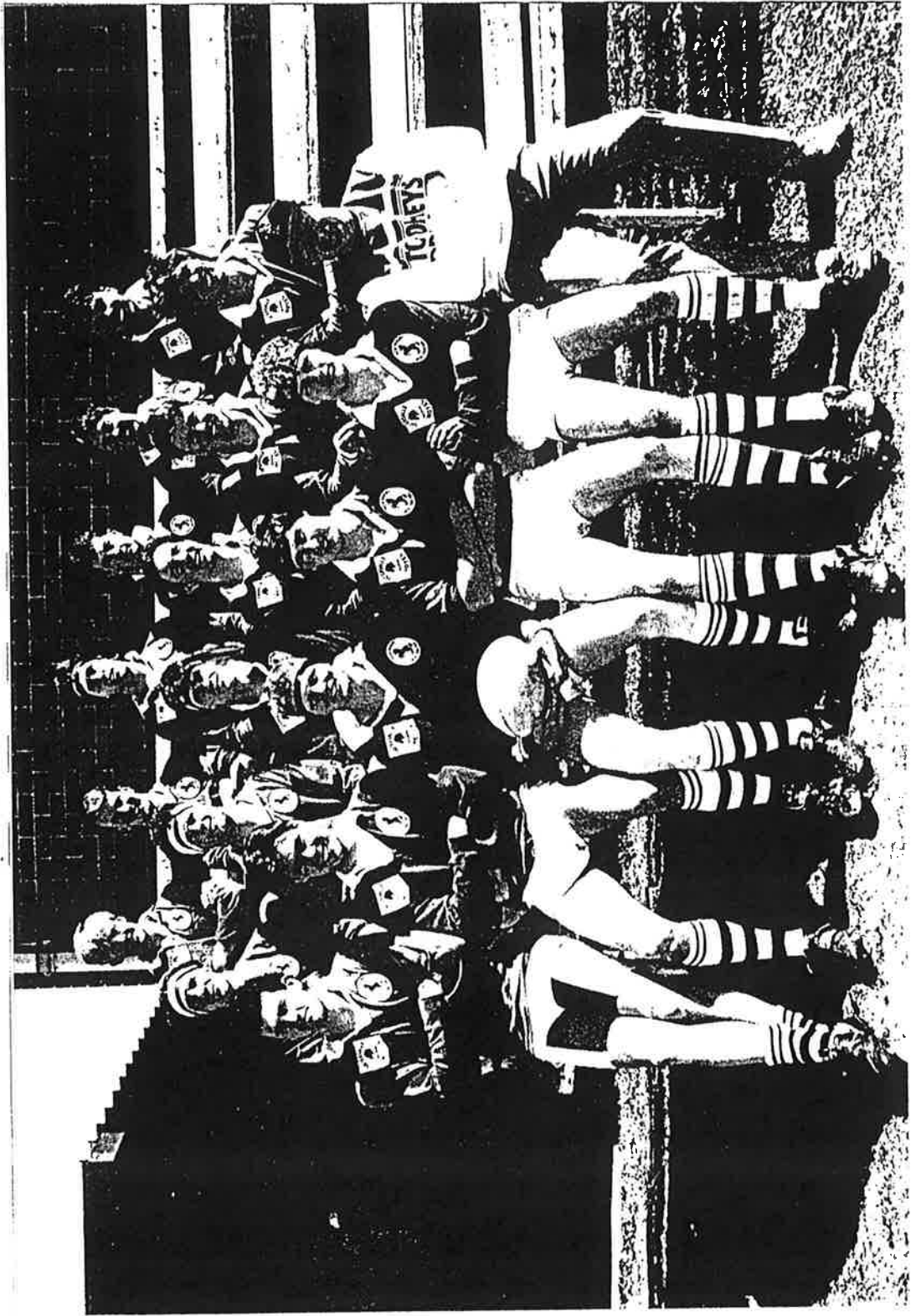
